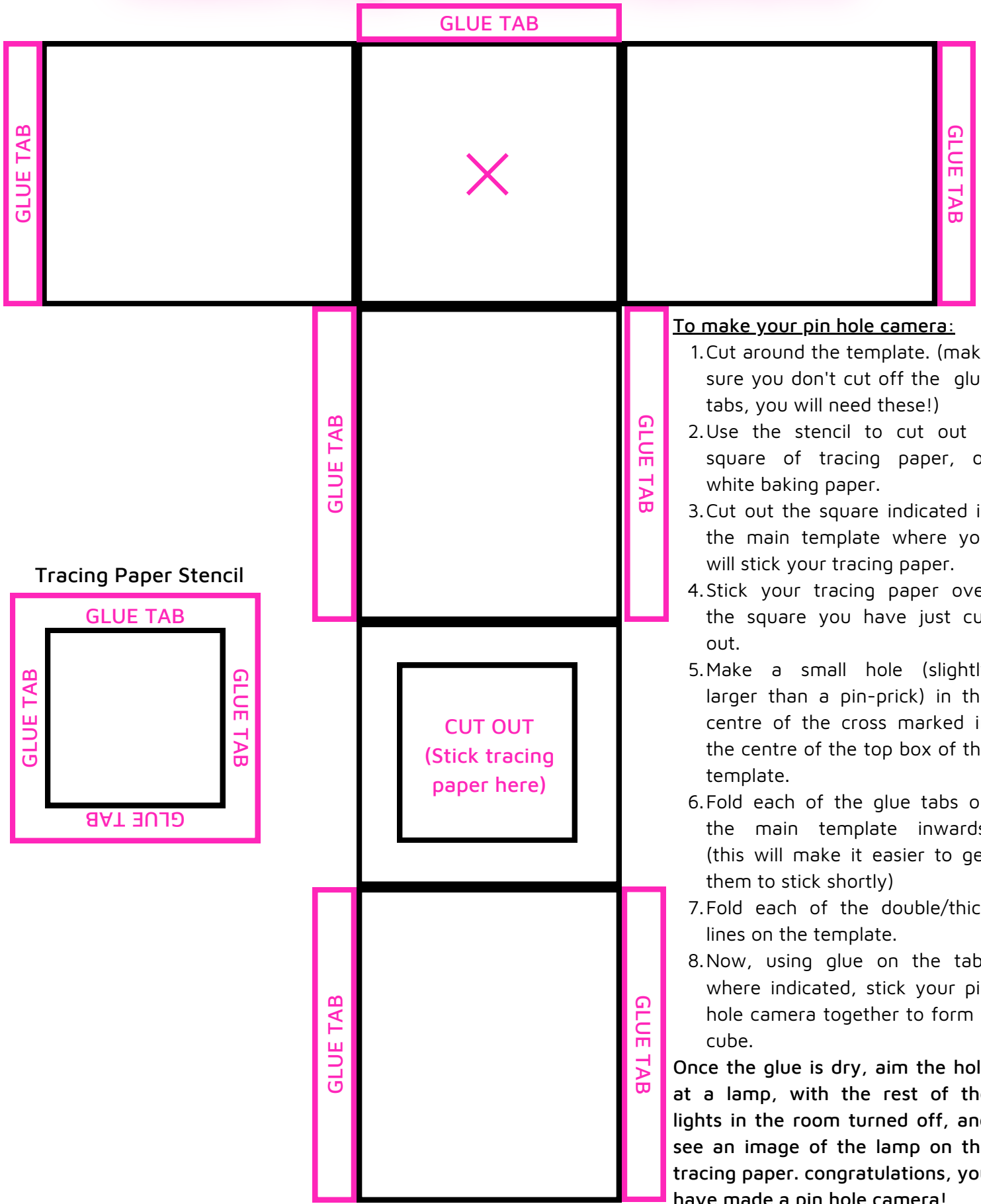


make a pin hole camera



To make your pin hole camera:

1. Cut around the template. (make sure you don't cut off the glue tabs, you will need these!)
2. Use the stencil to cut out a square of tracing paper, or white baking paper.
3. Cut out the square indicated in the main template where you will stick your tracing paper.
4. Stick your tracing paper over the square you have just cut out.
5. Make a small hole (slightly larger than a pin-prick) in the centre of the cross marked in the centre of the top box of the template.
6. Fold each of the glue tabs on the main template inwards. (this will make it easier to get them to stick shortly)
7. Fold each of the double/thick lines on the template.
8. Now, using glue on the tabs where indicated, stick your pin hole camera together to form a cube.

Once the glue is dry, aim the hole at a lamp, with the rest of the lights in the room turned off, and see an image of the lamp on the tracing paper. congratulations, you have made a pin hole camera!

Tip: You can also try turning off the lights and closing the curtains, with your pin-hole pointing through a small gap in the curtains, can you see an image of the view through the window?
