Suggestions for activities based in our Walled Gardens:

Art and Design

- Our garden contains a variety of subjects for drawing and design activities including plants, sculptures and historic buildings.

Maths

- Our 17th Century garden lends itself to measuring activities such as calculating perimeter and area and discussion of shapes and angles.
- Statistics - survey insects, birds or plants

Storytelling. Tell the story of ...

- a Victorian maid working at Mark Hall or garden boy working in the Walled Gardens.
- a horse that was stabled here in the museum building.
- the adventures of animals who visit the garden at night.
- Write a poem inspired by the gardens. Use your 5 senses.

Geography

- Draw a map of the Walled Gardens, including use of a key.

Science

- Seasons: What evidence can you observe of the current season?
- Materials: How many different materials can you find in the Walled Gardens? What have they been used for and why?
